

ABSTRACT

This research aims to contrastive analysis of two accent systems: Russian and Greek, in the teaching of Russian in Greek-speaking audience. The first part presents the characteristics of the Russian accent system, in the second part the Greek accent system's rules are developed and the third part is devoted to comparing these two systems, reporting similarities and identifying differences. An important part is the analysis and classification of the errors on the accent, which the Greeks do when dealing with learning Russian and the methodological advice that is suggested based on the results of the research on errors arisen. To develop the research contrastive approach has been used, which primarily aims to highlight differences of the compared languages. The conclusions were studied in detail and demonstrate the importance of the issue of accent and the need for deeper teaching of the rules governing it.
